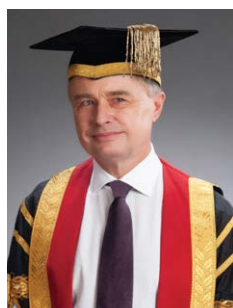

Chancellor

John Allen LLB *Wgtn*

John Allen is an experienced company director and the chief executive of WellingtonNZ. He chairs the University Council's people and culture committee and the nominations panel, and is a trustee on the Victoria University of Wellington Foundation board. In addition, he is a member of Te Herenga Waka's Wellington Uni-Professional board. Mr Allen is a former chief executive of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, the New Zealand Post Group, and the New Zealand Racing Board, and is a former partner in the law firm Rudd Watts & Stone. He was previously co-chair of the Australia New Zealand Leadership Forum as well as a director on a number of boards, including those of Datacom, Kiwibank, the New Zealand International Festival of the Arts, the New Zealand Stroke Foundation, the Nikau Foundation, and Te Papa Tongarewa. Mr Allen is an alumnus of the University and has previously been a visiting lecturer in the Faculty of Law. He received a Distinguished Alumni Award in 2006. Mr Allen was appointed to the University Council in 2018 and assumed the Chancellorship in 2022.



Pro-Chancellor

Honourable Maryan Street DipTchg ACE, BA BA(Hons) *Wgtn*, MPhil(Hons) *Auck*, AMusTCL

The Honourable Maryan Street was elected Pro-Chancellor of Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington by the University Council in August 2022 and is a director of KiwiRail Holdings Limited. Additionally, she chairs the University's audit and risk committee and sits on the people and culture committee. A former cabinet minister, Ms Street brings detailed and practical knowledge of government and parliamentary processes to the University. During her career, she has participated in many international engagements, including human rights roles. She has proven leadership of cross-interest groups and the ability to represent views and policies in both public and private sectors.



Vice-Chancellor

Professor Nic Smith BEng *Auck*, MA *Oxon*, PhD *Auck*

Professor Nic Smith was appointed Tumu Whakarāe—Vice-Chancellor of Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington in late 2022 and began in the role in 2023. Prior to this, Professor Smith held professorial appointments as provost of the Queensland University of Technology, dean of engineering at the University of Auckland, head of biomedical engineering at King's College London, and was a professor of computational physiology at the University of Oxford. In all these roles, he has continued an active teaching and research practice. This work has focused on the development of unique computational models that have been integrated with patient images and applied in hospitals to improve the diagnosis and treatment of heart disease. Professor Smith has authored more than 170 peer-reviewed journal publications and 350 conference publications and has been the lead author on several patent applications for the development of physiological models for specific clinical applications. He is a fellow of the Royal Society Te Apārangi and Engineering New Zealand.



Provost

Professor Wendy Larner *BSocSc Waik, MA(Hons) Cant, PhD Carleton*

Professor Wendy Larner is an internationally respected social scientist whose research sits in the interdisciplinary fields of globalisation, governance, and gender. She has held academic positions at the University of Waikato, the University of Auckland, and the University of Bristol (United Kingdom), and visiting fellowships at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (United States), Queen Mary University of London (United Kingdom), and the University of Frankfurt (Germany). Her research has been recognised with a range of scholarships and awards, including a Canadian Commonwealth Scholarship and a Fulbright Senior Fellowship. Professor Larner is president of the Royal Society Te Apārangi; a fellow of the New Zealand Geographical Society, and the Academy of Social Sciences (United Kingdom); and a principal fellow of the Higher Education Academy.



Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Māori)

Professor Rawinia Higgins (Tūhoe) *DipMāori BA Wgtn, PGDipArts MA PhD Otago, CELTA RSA/Cambridge, PFHEA, FRSNZ*

Professor Rawinia Higgins was appointed Tumu Ahurei—Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Māori) in 2016. She was previously Assistant Vice-Chancellor (Māori Research) and head of school for Te Kawa a Māui—the School of Māori Studies. Professor Higgins came to Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington as a senior lecturer in 2009 after holding academic positions at the University of Otago for 12 years. Her research expertise is Māori language revitalisation and, more specifically, language planning and policy. Professor Higgins is a board member of the Reserve Bank of New Zealand and a member of the Waitangi Tribunal, and has served on a number of governance boards for government and her iwi. In 2018, she was appointed chair and commissioner for Te Taura Whiri i te Reo Māori, the Māori Language Commission. She is the first woman to hold this role. In 2017, Professor Higgins won the Te Waiti award for te reo Māori and tikanga Māori at the Matariki Awards and, in 2018, she won the Education section of the Wellingtonian of the Year Awards. In 2020, she was awarded the Pou Aronui Award by the Royal Society Te Apārangi for distinguished service to aronui (humanities) over a sustained period of time.



Dean of Te Wāhanga Waihanga-Hoahoa—the Wellington Faculty of Architecture and Design Innovation

Professor Robyn Phipps *PBBSc BArch(Hons) Wgtn, PhD Massey*

Professor Robyn Phipps was appointed dean of Te Wāhanga Waihanga-Hoahoa—the Wellington Faculty of Architecture and Design Innovation in October 2022. She joined the faculty as a professor of Building Science in the Wellington School of Architecture in January 2021 and has been head of school since February 2022. An internationally respected researcher in the performance of homes and schools, Professor Phipps is known for her expertise in sustainable, low-carbon, and low-cost solutions for indoor environments that promote wellbeing. She is currently chair of the Ministry of Education's Ventilation Technical Advisory Group for the COVID-19 response, a director of the New Zealand Green Building Council, and a founding member of the New Zealand Indoor Air Quality Research Centre. For her work with the He Kainga Oranga Healthy Housing Research Group, Professor Phipps received the 2014 Prime Minister's Science Research Team Prize and the 2021 Rutherford Medal, and in 2022 received the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors' Lifetime Achievement Award.



Dean of Ōrauāriki—the Wellington School of Business and Government

Professor Jane Bryson *BSc Otago, MSc(Hons) Cant, PhD Wgtn*

Professor Jane Bryson was appointed dean of Ōrauāriki—the Wellington School of Business and Government in 2022 after 18 months acting in the role. Prior to this, she was deputy dean and associate dean (research) for the faculty. Professor Bryson joined Victoria University of Wellington in 1999 after a successful career in human resources and management.

Her career and research converge in one overarching concern: how we can facilitate the achievement of human capability through work. Professor Bryson's current areas of research include the investigation of human resource management practices in the context of work and society, multidisciplinary perspectives on people at work, and examining aspirations and influences on workers.



Associate Dean (Academic Programmes) of Ōrauāriki—the Wellington School of Business and Government

Professor John Randal *DipFinMath MSc PhD Wgtn*

Professor John Randal has been on the management team at Ōrauāriki—the Wellington School of Business and Government since 2015. He has been a part of the Victoria University of Wellington community for more than three decades, having first joined as a student in 1992. As well as his current role as associate dean, Professor Randal is a teaching professor in the School of Economics and Finance, and is the director of the Teaching Intensive Academic Career Pathway, a programme he has been key in developing. As an applied statistician, he has published in diverse fields, including the economics of charitable behaviour, taxation, financial econometrics, and robust statistics. Beyond his academic performance, Professor Randal is a committed advocate for people with mental illness and, in 2018, he was part of a group of cyclists who rode the Tour de France route to raise funds and awareness for the Mental Health Foundation of New Zealand.



Acting Dean of Te Whānau o Ako Pai—the Wellington Faculty of Education

Professor Carmen Dalli *BA(Hons) Malta, MEd Bristol, PhD Wgtn*

Professor Carmen Dalli was appointed acting dean of Te Whānau o Ako Pai—the Wellington Faculty of Education in late 2022. She first joined Victoria University of Wellington in 1988, playing a lead role in the establishment of the Institute for Early Childhood Studies in 1995 and serving as its director for many years. Throughout her career,

Professor Dalli has influenced policy and practice; notably, she was chair of the ministerial advisory group that developed the 10-Year Early Learning Action Plan for Aotearoa New Zealand (2019–2029). She is a pioneer of research into early childhood education, both within the University and internationally, and is known in particular for her work on pedagogy with children under three, teacher professionalism, and ethical practice within the early childhood care and education sector.



Dean of Te Wāhanga Ahunui Pūkaha— the Wellington Faculty of Engineering

Professor Dale Carnegie BSc MSc(Hons) PhD Waik

Professor Dale Carnegie was appointed dean of Te Wāhanga Ahunui Pūkaha—the Wellington Faculty of Engineering in January 2015. He has a Bachelor of Science in Physics, Mathematics, and Electronics; a Master of Science with First Class Honours in Physics and Electronics; and a doctorate in Computer Science. He came to Victoria University of Wellington in 2005 as an associate professor to help develop the University’s Engineering programme and was appointed professor in 2008, deputy head of the School of Engineering and Computer Science in 2009, and head of the School in 2012. Professor Carnegie’s research interests encompass mechatronics, adaptive control, sensors, embedded controllers, and engineering education. Some current research projects include developing robots to assist victim recovery following a disaster and creating new and novel robotic musical instruments.



Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Government, Law And Business

Professor Mark Hickford BA LLB(Hons) Auck, DPhil Oxf

Professor Mark Hickford became Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Government, Law and Business at Victoria University of Wellington in October 2021, having been Pro-Vice-Chancellor and Dean of Law since May 2015. He is also a practising barrister. He was in the Prime Minister’s Policy Advisory Group in the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet from 2010 until 2015, during which time he was seconded to the Ministry for Primary Industries as chief legal adviser and director of its Legal Services Directorate from August 2013 until April 2014. Prior to that, he spent eight years as a Crown counsel specialising in public law, the Treaty of Waitangi, Māori–Crown relations, and natural resources law. During that time, he was seconded to the New Zealand Law Commission to assist the then president, the Right Honorable Sir Geoffrey Palmer. Earlier in his career, he practised law in the private sector in Wellington and Auckland. He was the 2008 New Zealand Law Foundation International Research Fellow and has held visiting positions at Nuffield College at the University of Oxford and the Centre for Public Law at Victoria University of Wellington.



Dean of Te Wāhanga Tātai Hauora— the Wellington Faculty of Health

Professor Markus Melloh MD FU Berlin, DMedSc Charité, MPH SSPH+, PhD Otago, MBA EBS

Professor Markus Melloh was appointed dean of Te Wāhanga Tātai Hauora—the Wellington Faculty of Health in September 2021. He is an international expert in orthopaedics, public health, and digital transformation. He was previously the associate dean research and development and foundation director of the Institute of Health Sciences and a professor of public health at the Zurich University of Applied Sciences. He was deputy director of Zurich University’s Digital Health Lab, and a board member of the Zurich Digital Initiative. He is also the founder of a spin-off company working across the sectors of health, physics, engineering, and life sciences, and holds patents from the United States and Europe on dynamic real-time 3D pressure measurement in biological systems. He is also co-chair of the International Task Force on Diagnosis and Management of Lumbar Spinal Stenosis that won the International Society for the Study of the Lumbar Spine Clinical Prize in 2016.



Acting Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Humanities and Social Sciences and Education

Professor Sarah Leggott BA MA PhD *Auck*

Professor Sarah Leggott has been acting pro-vice-chancellor of Te Wāhanga Aronui—the Wellington Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and Te Whānau o Ako Pai—the Wellington Faculty of Education since March 2022. In that role, she has responsibility for overall leadership of the two faculties. Professor Leggott joined the University in 1998 as its first lecturer in Spanish and has held various leadership roles, most recently as dean of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. As professor of Spanish, her research expertise is in the field of Spanish literary and cultural studies, and she has published extensively on works by women writers related to the Spanish Civil War, Franco’s dictatorship, and Spain’s transition to democracy.



Acting Dean of Te Wāhanga Aronui—the Wellington Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences

Professor Simon Mackenzie LLB(Hons) Dip LP *Edin*, PG Dip *Keele*, MPhil *Cantab*, PhD *Melb*

Professor Simon Mackenzie was appointed acting dean of Te Wāhanga Aronui—the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in March 2022, having been head of the School of Social and Cultural Studies since 2020. Professor Mackenzie joined Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington as professor of Criminology in 2016, after nearly 10 years as reader, and then professor, in the Scottish Centre for Crime and Justice Research at the University of Glasgow. As professor of Criminology, he is internationally renowned for his research into white-collar crime and transnational organised crime. His latest books include *Trafficking Culture* (2019) and *Transnational Criminology* (2020). Professor Mackenzie has attracted research funding throughout his career from the European Union, government agencies, national research councils, and the United Nations.



Dean of Te Kauhanganui Tātai Ture—the Faculty of Law

Professor Lee Godden BA(Hons) MA *Melb*, BLS *Macquarie*, PhD *Griffith*

Professor Lee Godden joined Te Kauhanganui Tātai Ture—the Faculty of Law as dean in November 2022. She is a leading researcher in environmental law and its intersection with Indigenous peoples’ rights to land and resources, as well as property law and legal theory. She has been an academic at the University of Melbourne for the past two decades, leading many research programmes during this time including projects involving Māori law and the Treaty of Waitangi in Aotearoa New Zealand. She was an Australian law reform commissioner from 2013 to 2015, leading a review of native title claims under the Native Title Act 1993. She is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Law and of the Academy of Social Sciences in Australia. She is widely published, has held visiting professor positions internationally, and has been a member of numerous expert panels and advisory groups.



Dean of Te Wāhanga Pūtaiao—the Wellington Faculty of Science

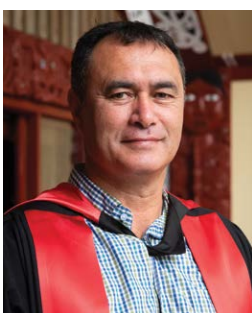
Professor Louise Dixon BSc(Hons) *Birm*, MSc *Liv*, PhD *Birm*, HCPC Registered Forensic Psychologist, NZPB Registered Psychologist

Professor Louise Dixon was appointed dean of Te Wāhanga Pūtaiao—the Wellington Faculty of Science in May 2022, the first woman appointed to the role, after serving as acting dean of the Faculty for one year. She joined Victoria University of Wellington in 2015 after 14 years working as an academic at the Centre for Forensic and Family Psychology at the University of Birmingham. As a registered forensic psychologist and professor of Forensic Psychology, she is internationally renowned for her scientific research into the prevention of interpersonal and family violence. Her research has a strong applied element that influences practice and policy in several fields, including corrections, policing, psychology, and health-related disciplines.



Te Ripowai Higgins (Tūhoe) QSM, DipMāori *Wgtn*, MPhil *NU Malaysia*, MA (Honoris Causa) *UKL*

Te Ripowai Higgins has taught and served students, staff, and visitors at Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington for 25 years, first as a lecturer in social work, then as a senior lecturer and head of school of Te Kawa a Māui—School of Māori Studies. She then took up the role of ruahine, the female cultural leader, and then taurima, the marae manager of Te Herenga Waka. She has been involved in Māori language initiatives since the 1970s, including Te Ataarangi (a community-based programme for adult Māori language learning), Te Ūpoko o Te Ika Māori Radio, and Te Māngai Pāho (the Māori Broadcasting Funding Agency). She has been a long-standing Māori adviser to the New Zealand Law Commission and other government agencies, and served as one of the kaumātua for former Governor-General Dame Patsy Reddy.



Mike Ross (Ngāti Hauā) PGDipReo *MMMgt Raukawa*, DipMāori *MPP Wgtn*, PhD *Auck UT*

Mike Ross began working at Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington in 2011. Prior to that, he worked for many years as a youth and community worker, during which time he studied at Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington and then at Te Wānanga o Raukawa. From these experiences, he has an interest in whānau and hapū development, iwi governance, Māori history, and Māori language and customs.



Dr Ben Walker (Ngāti Raukawa) BCA(Hons) *MCA PhD Wgtn*

Dr Ben Walker is a lecturer in organisational behaviour at Ōrauāriki—the Wellington School of Business and Government. His teaching and research focuses on the ‘people side’ of work and management. He is the course coordinator of the Introduction to Management course, through which he introduces more than 1,000 students each year to the study of management. His current research explores the origins and outcomes of individuals’ performance-based identities, people’s hidden assumptions about the nature of expertise, and the negative psychological processes connected with professional success.

A HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington’s graduation ceremonies are held at the Michael Fowler Centre and at Te Herenga Waka marae. Graduation at the marae was instigated by Professor Hirini Moko Mead, the University’s founding Professor of Māori Studies. The marae ceremony is an opportunity for graduates and their whānau to acknowledge and celebrate the Māori dimension of their student lives in a Māori setting through the application of tikanga Māori.

Graduation ceremonies combine tikanga Māori and academic tradition that dates back to the twelfth century when the first universities appeared. The words ‘university’ and ‘degree’ are both derived from Latin, the language used by scholars in the Middle Ages. The Latin term *universitas* meant a guild or union, formed by the ‘masters’ (MAs) who held a licence to teach.

‘Degree’ and ‘graduate’ come from *gradus*, meaning step. The first step taken by students was admission to a Bachelor degree; the second and final step made them a Master and won them admission to the *universitas*.

In the old days, the new Master had to deliver an inaugural lecture, take the whole *universitas* of Masters out to dinner, and preside over disputations for 40 days. Graduating Masters at the University will be relieved to know that this practice was dispensed with some time ago.

The title of Chancellor was originally that of the Bishop’s secretary. The Bishop had the right to grant licences to teach in his diocese, at a time when the Church held a virtual monopoly on learning, but he tended to depute this job to his Chancellor. Later, the Pope assumed the power to grant licences to teach anywhere, not just in specified dioceses, and the Chancellor conferred degrees on his behalf.

During the Reformation in Britain, Henry VIII took over all the powers of the Pope, including that of granting degrees. Consequently, the Chancellor’s robes are not ecclesiastical, but similar to those worn by the Lord Chancellor of England.

The gowns worn by the graduates and academic staff, however, are fashioned after the dress of the medieval clergy, although those of the Middle Ages were fastened at the front; the fashion for wearing the gowns open at the front resulted from a desire to show off the fine clothes underneath. The hood was also a normal medieval garment, the coloured lining being added a little later. Since the 1600s, the colours of the hoods have been strictly controlled, so that a graduate’s hood colour denotes their university and degree.

CEREMONIAL ROBES



The colours of the graduates' hoods or stoles—ranging from nasturtium to pompadour and peacock green—denote the degree achieved, and are special to Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington.

The official academic dress for graduates attending a ceremony is a gown, hood or stole, and cap. The cap has been defined as a black trencher with a tassel for every degree except Doctor's degrees. Doctorates wear a John Knox cap.

Those attending a ceremony to receive a diploma or a certificate wear a gown and a Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington stole, not the hood and trencher. However, if they already hold a degree, they wear the garments appropriate for that degree. Graduates may, if they wish, embellish their graduation regalia with garments of honour from their cultural traditions.

The University's gowns are modelled on those used at the University of Cambridge. The gown for a Bachelor's degree is the same as for the Cambridge Bachelor of Arts, and those for Master's and Doctor of Philosophy degrees are the same as for a Cambridge Master of Arts. The gown for other Doctor's degrees is as for the Cambridge Master of Arts but is made of scarlet silk or cloth.

The hood for every degree is the same as for the Cambridge Master of Arts. The hood for a Bachelor's degree is lined with coloured silk and bordered with white fur, while the hood for a Bachelor's degree with Honours is lined with coloured silk and edged with white silk, and a Master's hood or stole omits the fur. The stole for a Doctor of Philosophy degree is lined with red silk, and the hood for other Doctor's degrees is made wholly of silk.

HONORARY DOCTORATE CITATION

Professor Robert Hunter Wade

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Commerce, honoris causa

Professor Robert Hunter Wade is a world-leading political economist, whose research has focused on questions around economic growth, globalisation, income inequality, and governance. He is currently professor of global political economy at the London School of Economics and Political Science, one of the foremost social science universities in the world.

Professor Wade completed his Bachelor of Arts majoring in economics at the University of Otago in the mid-1960s, before moving to Wellington, where he completed his Bachelor of Arts with First Class Honours at Victoria University of Wellington in 1966. He then moved to the United Kingdom, where he continued his postgraduate studies towards a Master's degree and later a PhD at the University of Sussex.

He remained at the University of Sussex for some years, working as a fellow and subsequently as a professorial fellow in its Institute of Development Studies.

His career has spanned more than 40 years working as an economist and professor and undertaking research fellowships at prestigious institutions in America and Europe. He has been highly influential in his field and sought after for expertise and insights. He has held positions at Brown University, the MIT Sloan School of Management, Princeton University, the United States Congress, and the World Bank.

His research centres on the Adam Smith question of why some countries and people are rich and many others so poor. This has led him to research on land reform, water reform, and reform of state bureaucracies, on the causes of the exceptional economic success of Northeast Asia, on finance-driven globalisation and the crises it brings, and on the functioning of multilateral economic organisations such as the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund. The bedrock question is how material prosperity can be spread more widely and in an environmentally resilient way. He has carried out fieldwork in India, Italy, Pitcairn Island, South Korea, Taiwan, and inside the World Bank.

Professor Wade has produced a significant number of articles and publications, including the critically acclaimed book *Governing the Market*, which won an American Political Science Association award in 1992. The book has since been translated into Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, and Vietnamese.

In 2008, he received the prestigious Leontief Prize for Advancing the Frontiers of Economic Thought, in recognition of his outstanding contribution to economic theory that addresses contemporary realities and supports just and sustainable societies.

Professor Wade regularly shares his expertise through public talks and news articles, and inspires future generations through teaching and supervising postgraduate students.

His scholarship, teaching, and insights into some of the most significant challenges facing the world's societies make him a fitting recipient of an honorary doctorate.

HIGHER DOCTORATE CITATION

Christina Joy Barton

Admitted to the degree of Doctor of Literature

Associate Professor Christina Joy Barton is a respected art historian, writer, and curator with specialised expertise in the history of art after 1960 in New Zealand.

She completed her Master of Arts in Art History with first class honours at the University of Auckland in 1988. During her studies, she worked as a tutor and assistant lecturer in art history at the university, and then later as a research assistant at the Auckland Art Gallery Research Library.

From there, she held curator positions at some of New Zealand's key art institutions, including the Auckland City Art Gallery and the Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa. In 1995, she joined Victoria University of Wellington as a lecturer in Art History and has spent more than 20 years teaching here, progressing to the roles of senior lecturer, programme director, and associate professor.

In 2007, Associate Professor Barton was appointed director of the University's custom-built gallery, Te Pātaka Toi Adam Art Gallery. The gallery presents a variety of highly regarded exhibitions and manages Ngā Puhipuhi o Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington Art Collection. She brings a wealth of experience to this role and has been able to maximise both her academic and curatorial strengths to develop the gallery as a key platform for teaching and research.

Associate Professor Barton's research, teaching, and curatorial practice mostly focuses on art in Aotearoa New Zealand, especially as it evolved after 1960. She works closely with artists and is always concerned to think about art and its histories in relation to wider social, cultural, political, and institutional contexts.

She has curated numerous exhibitions, including the major Billy Apple retrospective at the Auckland Art Gallery in 2015. Her writing has been published widely, with more than 160 published items, and she has contributed as a co-editor of the journals *Antic* and *Reading Room*.

Her most recent work, *Billy Apple: Life/Work*, is the first monograph on New Zealand's most important conceptual artist, who died in 2021. This book-length study is an original contribution to the literature on the artist that carefully sets out his contributions to the British, American, and New Zealand art scenes from the 1960s to the present through first-hand research in the artist's exhaustive archive.

Associate Professor Barton's scholarship has been recognised throughout her career. Most notably, she was made a Member of the New Zealand Order of Merit for her services to art history and curation in the 2021 New Year Honours.

This higher degree, a Doctor of Literature, is awarded to Associate Professor Barton in recognition of the immense contribution she has made to the arts and to highlighting New Zealand artists and their work. Her insights are an important and lasting contribution to New Zealand art history. Her creativity and passion are inspiring, and are the values we seek to instil in all our graduates.
