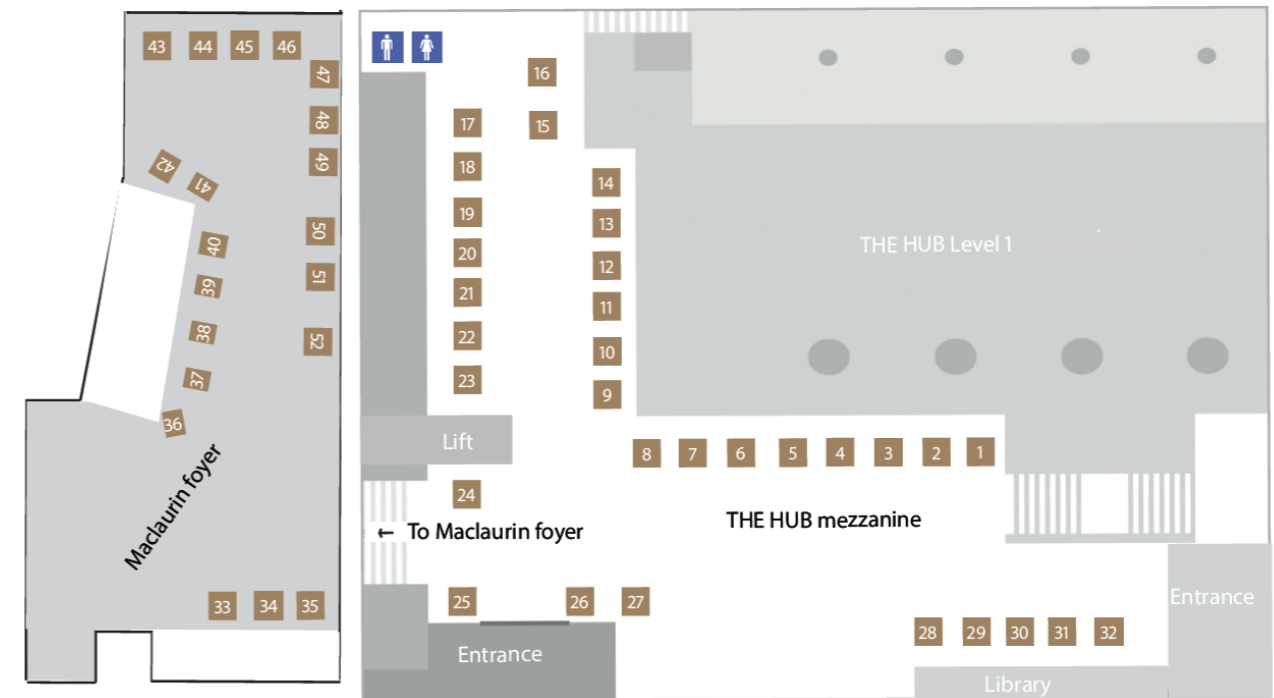
### Commercial Communications Council (1)
