2 NGĀ WHĀINGA ME NGĀ MAHI

Aims, Objectives and Content

2.1 Ngā Whāinga

Ko te kaupapa matua tonu o te karaehe nei he whakawhanake i te reo Māori kia matomato tonu te tupu, ka mutu, mā roto katoa mai i ngā whakataukī, whakatauākī, ngā kupu whakarite ka ahu mai i ngā tuhinga a ngā tohunga o te reo o onamata, o nāianei. Koirā te taumata e whāia ana i roto i tēnei wānanga.

Na reira ka pānuitia, ka tātarihia, ka wetewetea e te akomanga kātahi ka whakamātauria, ka wānangahia, ka whakamahia i roto i te huhua o ngā whakaritenga kia ranongahia tōna reka kia ngata rawa tō hiakai mo tēnei wāhanga o tō hīkoi i roto i tō tāua reo rangatira.

2.2 Ngā Akomanga Whāiti

E rua hāora ia wiki e whakawātea ana koutou ki te kuhu i a koutou ki roto i ngā mahi o roto i ngā huinga whakapakari. No kona, me kōrero ka tika. Kei noho ka haere mai he whakakeke kē te mahi.

3.2 Mahi whakarongo 10%

Ko te tikanga o tēnei mahi he whakamātau i te tauira ki tōna kakama ki te tere mau i ngā kōrero a te hunga mātau, i ētahi wā he pōturi te reo, i ētahi wā ka maringi noa mai ngā kupu. Ko te mārama ki ngā kōrero te whainga matua o tēnei mahi. Ka whakamahia tēnei i roto i te **akomanga whānui hei te Paraire o te wiki tuawhā**.

3.3 Kōrero Tene 10%

Mā te kaiako e whakarite ngā kaupapa mo te kōrero tene. He ohorere te hoatu o ngā kaupapa ki a koutou, kia tūtakarerewā ai koutou ki te kōrero i ngā wā katoa. Akene pea he tautohetohe te mahi, akene pea he whakapūaki whakaaro mō ngā kōrero nui o te wā – ko wai ka hua, ko wai ka tohu!

Heoi ka aromatawai koutou e au mo te kaha ki te whakapuaki whakaaro, mo te puku kōrero whaikiko, kāre mo te pahupahu noa iho mo te kōrero kore take noa rānei!

E 5 meneti te roa, e 2 meneti mo ngā pātai (1% te whiu ki te iti iho, ki te roa ake rānei).

Ka tū ngā kōrero tene i roto i ngā **akomanga whānui a te wiki tuawaru**.

3.4 Tuhinga Roa 20%

Kotahi noa iho te tuhinga roa. Ko tōna nui kia kauā e iti iho i te 2000 kupu kia kauā hoki e nui ake i te 2500 kupu.

Me ū mai a te Paraire i te **wiki ngahuru** i mua i te 5 karaka i te ahiahi.

3.5 Te tātari tuhinga kōrero 10%

Me matua mōhio te tauira ki te whakamārama i ngā kōrero ā tuhi ka tika. No reira ka pihi ake tēnei o ngā momo whakamātautau. Ka tukuna e te kaiwhakaako ētahi pānuitanga hei pānui mā koutou kātahi ka noho koutou ki te whakamārama mai te tikanga o ngā kōrero kei roto. Me mau i a koe te ngako o ngā kōrero ki te whakatauria mai i tō mātau ki tēnei momo mahi. **Ka mahia ēnei mahi i roto i ngā akomanga whāiti hei te wiki tuarua.**

3.6 Kauhau 15%

Ka whakahaeretia tēnei i roto i te akomanga whānui a te wiki 10. E 8 meneti te roa, e 2 meneti mo ngā pātai (2% te whiu ki te iti iho, ki te roa ake rānei).

- 9 Ko wai te tangata pai katoa ki a koe, ā, e hiahia ai koe kia rite tonu koe ki a ia.
- 10 Tō pae tawhiti me pēhea e ū ai i a koe.
- 11 He mahi whakatumatuma? E ai ki te Kāwanatanga me te iwi Māori.

3.7 Te Whakamātautau Whāiti 20%

Ka whakahaeretia i roto i te Akomanga Whānui a te **Wiki ngahuru mā rua**. He hāora me te hāwhe te roanga o tēnei mahi.

Ka ahu mai i ngā mahi katoa kua whakahaeretia i roto i tēnei akomanga. He mahi whakarongo, he mahi pānui, he whakautu pātai.

3.8 Mahi Kainga 10%

Ka tukuna he mahi kainga ki a koutou ki roto i ngā Akomanga whāiti. Ina, ka tukuna tēnei mahi kainga i te wiki 1 me whakahokia mai hei te wiki 3. Me tukuna te katoa o ēnei mahi kainga ki te kaituruki i mua i te timatatanga o ngā akomanga whāiti. Mā te kaituruki e whakamārama atu te roanga o ngā mahi nei i te wiki 3 ki roto i ngā akomanga whāiti.

4 E PUTA AI KI TE WHAI AO KI TE AO MARAMA
Course Requirements

- Me tae mai ki te nuinga o ngā karaihe, kia 20 rā mai i te 24.
- Me tae ki te nuinga o nga Akomanga Whaiti ara kia 7 o te 10.
- Me eke ia mahi whakamatautau ki te 50% o te whiwhinga i whakaritea (50% pass in each piece of assessment).

- Ka taea e te tauira te whakarāpopoto tētahi kaupapa nāna i rangahau, mō te tekau meneti kia eke ki te tau tuarua i te whare wānanga tōna taumata.
- Ka mōhio te tauira ki ngā ture tuhi a Te Kawa a Māui.
- Ka mōhio te tauira ki ngā ture whakatakoto kōrero-a-waha a Te Kawa a Māui.
- Ka taea e te tauira te rangahau he kōrero ki te taumata tau tuarua.
- Ka mātau hoki ki ngā tikanga rangahau a te whare wānanga.

6 NGĀ WHIU
Penalties

Ki te kore e tutuki i a koe ngā whakaritenga mō ia tatauranga, kāore koe e hipa i tēnei karaihe. Me ū mai te katoa o ngā mahi i te rā kua whakaritea. Ka tangohia 5% mō ia rā ki te tōmuri. 9 ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND PLAGIARISM

- an oral or written warning
- cancellation of your mark for an assessment or a fail grade for the course
- suspension from the course or the University.

It is not enough just to stop attending lectures and tutorials, or to tell your lecturer or school administrator. You must complete a change of course form, available from your Faculty, Student and Academic Services Office, and submit it by the following deadlines.

First Trimester Courses, February to June 2008

No addition of first trimester courses permitted after Friday, 7 March 2008.

Withdraw before **Friday, 7 March 2008** and you will get a full refund of fees.

Full-Year Courses, March to October 2008

No addition of full-year courses permitted after Friday, 21 March 2008.

Withdraw before **Friday, 7 March 2008** and you will get a full refund of fees.
