Further explanations for assessments:

5.1 Te Hanga Rauemi 10%

Ko te tikanga o tēnei mahi he hanga i tētahi rauemi pai rawa atu mā ngā tamariki kei te ako i te reo Māori ki roto i ngā kura. Mauria mai tēnei aromatawai ki te akomanga whāiti tuatahi. Ka tū mai ia tauira ki te whakamārama, ki te kōrero mō tāna rauemi. Inā eke āu mahi ki te taumata e tika ana, akene pea ka whakaatuhia, ka whakamahia ki roto i ngā kura hei rauemi whakaako i ngā tamariki i te wiki o te reo Māori. Mauria mai tō hanga rauemi ki te akomanga whāiti, tāngia hoki tētahi whakarāpopoto, he whakamahuki e pā ana ki tō rauemi i mua i te wā tū ai te akomanga whāiti.

5.2 Tūmahi – Te Wiki o Te Reo Māori 15%

Ia tau ka tū tēnei kaupapa e kīa nei ko te wiki o te reo Māori. Hei te 27 o Hōngongoi ki te 2 o Hereturikōkā 2010 te wiki o te reo Māori. Nā reira, ko tā koutou mahi, tō koutou whakaaro ki tēnei kaupapa, he whakaako i ngā tauira o MAOR 102. E rua ngā wāhanga o tēnei mahi:

Wāhanga Tuatahi

Ko te mahi tuatahi māu, he whakarite mahere ako. Ka haramai a Karena, te Pūkenga o MAOR 102 ki te kōrero ki a koutou hei te wiki tuatahi, ki te whakamōhio atu he aha te taumata e tika ana mō ngā tauira nei. Ka whakaroopuhia koutou e te kaiako. Ka mahi ngātahi koutou ki te hanga i tētahi mahere ako. Ko te kaupapa mō te wiki o te reo Māori ko te kai. Nā reira whakaarohia tēnei kaupapa hei te wā ka whakarite koe i tō mahere ako. Whakarārangi haere ngā mahi, te roanga o ia mahi, ngā rauemi. Toru tekau meneti noa iho te roanga o ia akomanga. Whakaritea he wāhanga ka whakahaelehia e ia tangata kei roto i tō roopu. Inā tokoono koutou kei roto i tō rōpū whakaritea he mahi mā te katoa. Tohua tētahi o ngā tāngata kei roto i tō roopu hei tuku i te mahere ako mō tō roopu. Tukuna atu tō mahere ako ki runga Papapango hei te Wiki 2, **Rāpare, 22 Hōngongoi 2010**. Ka tukuna he 5% o te 15% mō tēnei wāhanga o te mahi.

Wāhanga Tuarua

Ka tū tētahi akomanga reo Māori mai te Rāhina ki te Rāmtere. Ka whiriwhiria tētahi o aua rā mā ia roopu ki te whakaako. Ka tū koutou ki mua i te aroaro o ngā tauira ka whakaako ai i a rātou i te reo Māori, he whakaako rānei i ētahi kōrero e pā ana ki te reo, ki ngā āhuatanga rānei o te ao Māori. Whaia ko te mahere ako kua whakaaehia e te pūkenga, kaua rawa e kotiti atu i tēnei mahere. Hei te katoa o te wiki tuatoru tū ai tēnei aromataawai. Ka tukuna he 10% o te 15% mō tēnei wāhanga o te mahi.

5.3 Kōrero Tene **10% (5% mō ia mahi)**

Ka whakahaeretia ēnei kaupapa ki roto i ngā akomanga whāiti ka tū hei te Wiki 5 me te Wiki 7. E 6 meneti te roa, e 2 meneti mō ngā pātai. Kāore e taea e te tauira te pupuri pepa, kāri āwhina (cue cards) rānei. Ia wā tū ai tētahi ki te kōrero ka tohua e te kaiako kia tokorua, tokotoru rānei o te akomanga whāiti ki te hanga patapātai mā te kaikōrero.

Mā te kaitūruki e whakarite ngā kaupapa mō te whakamātautau kōreo tene. He ohorere te hoatu o ngā kaupapa ki a koutou, kia tūtakarerewā ai koutou ki te kōrero i ngā wā katoa.

5.4 Ngā Whakamātautau Whāiti **30% (15% mō ia mahi)**

Ka whakahaeretia ki roto i te akomanga whānui hei ngā Wiki 6, 12 hoki. He hāora me te hāwhe te roanga o ia whakamātautau whāiti. He 15% ūrau mō ia whakamātautau. Akene pea he mahi whakarongo, he mahi pānui, he whakautu pātai, he tātari tuhinga kōrero, he mahi whakatikatika, he tuhinga iti kei roto i te whakamātautau. Ko te tāhuhu o ngā kōrero kei ngā whakamātautau nei kua ahu mai i ngā kaupapa whakaako kei roto i ngā akomanga whānui, whāiti hoki. Hei whakarite i a koutou ka whakatūhia e te kaiako he akomanga, e kiia rā, he hokinga whakamuri i te wā tū ai ngā akomanga whānui.

5.5 Kauhau **15%**

Ka whakahaeretia tēnei kaupapa i roto i ngā akomanga whānui e rua ka tū i te Wiki 8 me te noho marae. Tekau mā rua meneti te roa, e 2 meneti mō ngā pātai. Kāore e āhei te tauira te pupuri kāri āwhina (cue cards).

E rima meneti ki a koe ki te whakarite ō kōrero ā mua i tōu tū. Ka hamenehia ki te heke iho i te tekau meneti te roanga o tō tū, ā, ka tango he 2% mai i te kaute tōpū. I te wāhanga tuatahi o tēnei tau i whiriwhiria e koutou i ngā tūmomo rerenga kōrero, ā, i tukuna atu ngā whakamārama o aua kōrero rā, ka toru i whakaatu mai ētahi tauira rerenga kōrero mō aua kīwhaha, whakataukī, rerenga kōrero rā.

Ko tā koutou mahi ināianei he hoki anō ki ērā kōrero me te kimi i ētahi tauira anō e whakaatu mai ai i pēhea, me pēhea rānei te whakamahi i aua rerenga kōrero, kīwhaha, whakataukī, whakatauākī. Akene pea kua kōrerotia ēra kōrero ki runga whakaata, whakaari Māori, kua rongo rānei ki runga reo irirangi, kua tuhia kētia ki rō pukapuka, ki tētahi pukapuka maheni, ki runga ipurangi. Kohia ngā momo tauira katoa. Me wetewete me tātari te akonga i ngā kōrero ka kohia e ia.

Tāngia tō whakaaturanga ki runga Papapango ā mua i te rā tū ai tēnei aromatawai ki roto i te akomanga whānui.

Ki te kore e whai wāhi koe ki te oti i tēnei mahi i roto i te akomanga whānui ka mahia ki te noho marae ki roto i ngā akomanga whāiti rānei. Inā he pātai, he āwangawanga rānei, whakaritea he wā pai ki te kōrero tahi me te Pūkenga. Ka whakaatūhia he tauira mō tēnei aromatawai, ā, ka tukuna hoki te roanga o ngā whakamārama ki roto i ngā akomanga whānui, whāiti hoki.

5.6 Tuhingaroa 20%

Kotahi anake te tuhingaroa. Ko tōna nui kia kaua e iti iho i te 2000 kupu, kia kaua hoki e nui ake i te 2200 kupu. Me ū mai hei te 15 Whiringa ā nuku 2010. Me rangahau, me wetewete hoki te akonga i ngā momo kōrero e pā ana ki tētahi o ēnei kaupapa e whai ake nei, hoki atu ki ngā kōrero i rangahaua e koutou i te wāhanga tuatahi o te tau. Anei ngā kaupapa mo te tuhingaroa:

- tētahi pou o tō whare whakairō/wharenuī/wharepuni
- te reo ā iwi o tētahi iwi anake
- he rautaki hei whakapiki i te tokomaha o ngā tāne, wāhine rānei e ako ana i te reo
- tātarihia ngā tuhinga reo Māori, kōrero rānei e toru o tētahi o ēnei tāngata rongonui o te ao Māori: Timoti Karetu, Miria Simpson, Hoani Rangihau, Ngoi Pewhairangi, Tā Ropata Mahuta, Hone Tuwhare, Katerina Mataira, Huirangi Waikerepuru.

Anei anō ētahi mahi me whakaoti ā mua i te tuku mai i tō tuhingaroa:

- annotated bibliography (5%): Tāngia ki runga Papapango hei te Rātū, Wiki 9
- full draft: Tāngia ki runga Papapango hei te Rātū, Wiki 11
- peer-review (5%): Tāngia ki runga Papapango hei te Rātū, Wiki 12.

Tukuna mai te tuhingaroa i te rā kua whakaritea, arā, **15 Whiringa ā nuku 2010**. Tāngia ki runga Papapango i mua i te rima karaka. He 10% te ūrau mō tēnei wāhanga o te aromatawai.

Kia pai te whakatakoto i āu kōrero, tohungia ngā kaituhi, tāpirihia he rārangi kupu hou me ngā whakapuakanga. Kia kauā e iti iho i te rima ngā momo whakapuakanga ka whakamahia e koe mō tō tuhingaroa. Kia hāngai tonu ki ngā ture a Te Kawa a Māui 2007 mō te whakatakoto tuhituhi.

5.7 Noho Marae

Mandatory Course Requirement

Ako Pai Marae, Rāpare (5:00pm), 7 Whiringa-ā-nuku 2010 ki te Rāmere (8:00am), 8 Whiringa-ā-nuku 2010. Ko te kaupapa o tō tatou noho ko ngā mahi waiata o nehe, onāianei hoki. Kei te haramai ngā tauira o MAOR 318 hoki ki tēnei noho marae. He \$15.00 taara te koha mō te noho marae. Tukuna tō koha ki ngā kaimahi o te tari ki 50KP. Ki te kore koe e tae atu ki te noho marae he tuhingaroa te mahi. Kia 2000 ngā kupu, ko te kaupapa ko tētahi waiata tawhito. Tukuna mai tēnei i te rā tū ai te Noho Marae ki te tari Māori (Pouaka Aromatawai) i mua i te 5 karaka.

6 KO NGĀ WHIU

Inā, i oti i a koe tō mahi, ā, i tukuna hoki i te wā e tika ana engari kāore i eke rawa tō māka ki te rima tekau paiheneti ka āhei koe ki te tuku tuarua atu i tō aromatawai ki te kaiako. Heoi, ki te tuarua tō tuku mai i tētahi aromatawai e kore e eke i te rima tekau paiheneti te kaute tōpū mō taua aromatawai. Me kōrero ki te Pūkenga, māna anake e whakarite he wā e taea ai te whakaoti tika i āu mahi.

Ki te kore e tutuki i a koe ngā whakaritenga mō ia aromatawai, kāore koe e hipa i tēnei karaihe. Me ū mai te katoa o ngā mahi i te rā kua whakaritea. Ka tangohia 5% mō ia rā ki te tōmuri. Me kōrero ki te Pūkenga, māna anake e whakarite he wā e taea ai te whakaoti tika i āu mahi. Kaua e haere i te ara a taihoa, ka tae ki aua atu!

11 CLASS REPRESENTATIVE
