7 KO NGĀ WHIU

Kia mōhio mai koe, me tuku mai āu aromatawai katoa i te rā e tika ana. Inā tōmuri te tukuna mai, he 5% te whiunga mō ia rā i muri i te rā tuku (kia mataara mai, ko te Rāhoroi me te Rātapu hoki ka kautehia).

Inā pāngia koe e tētahi take ohorere, e raru ai tō whakatutuki i tētahi whakamātautau, me wawe te whakapā mai ki a au ki te tono whakaroanga. Kaua e haere i te ara a taihoa, ka tae ki aua atu! Kia mōhio mai koutou kāore e whakaehia e au ngā taumahatanga ā-whare wānanga, ā-mahi o waho hoki i te take whakararu i a koe.
