2.2 Ngā Wā Huinga Mā tāua e whakarite

Ko ētahi kua mene ki te pō, ko ētahi kei te takatū tonu. Ko te tino whāinga kia rongo tātou i te reka o te reo o ū tātou mātua tīpuna. Tuatahi kia eke ake ngā tauira o te wānanga ki te ikeketanga o te reo, kia mārama pū ki ngā kupu whakanikoniko i whaochia ki ētahi momo tuhinga reo, pēnei i ngā waiata tawhito, ngā whakataukī, ngā pūrākau, pakwaitara a kui mā a koro mā. Ko te mea nui kia

whakaaro hia te taumata o te reo tuhi me te reo kōrero e tika ana hei eketanga mā tātau, otirā, me pēhea e paku pātata atu ai ki tā rātau i whakatauira mai.

5 TE PAE TAWHITI

Ngā Hua ki ngā Akonga

Ki te oti pai i te akonga ngā mahi i whakaritea, ko ngā hua ka puta ko:

- 1 te mārama ki te hōhonutanga o ngā kōrero a ngā tohunga o mua
- 2 te kite i te rerekē o ngā tohunga o nehe me ū nāianei
- 3 te matatau ki ngā kōrero tuhituhi o mua
- 4 te whakatakoto tika i ētahi kōrero i whāia atu ko te tauira i ngā tuhituhinga ka pānuitia
- 5 ka takoto he rangahautanga nui mai ngā tuhituhinga
- 6 ka waihangahia he kōrero whakanikoniko.

6 NGĀ MAHI

Ko te kaupapa nui o te wānanga nei he arotake i ngā whakaaro, i te awe wairua rānei o te kaituhi, o te kaitito rānei e tākotokoto ana i roto i ā rātau tuhinga. Kia aha ai? Kia pai ai te kitea atu e ahu pēhea ana ngā whakaaro o aua kaituhi,

ka mutu, ki te ketuketu i te papa i nōhia ai e aua kaituhi rā e ara ake ai ngā tūmomo tikanga motuhake o aua rā, waihoki kia whai wāhi atu ki te tātari, ki te wewete i aua tikanga, ā, ka whakataurite ai ki ngā tikanga o ēnei rā mēnā rā he rerekētanga he aha kē rānei. Nā reira e kāwatatia ana koia nei te tino hua ka puta.

I roto i ēnei wānanga, ka riro mā koutou ngā kaupapa kōrero ka ahu mai i ngā tuhinga e whakarite. Hai ia rua wiki ka tīpakohia he kōrero hai wānanga mā te katoa, ā, ko te mahi a te kaiwhakarite, he tātari, he whakahaere i te kaupapa kōrero, i te wānanga. Nā reira me āta pānui ngā kaupapa i mua o te taenga mai ki ia akomanga.

ka whakahaerehia ki roto i ngā ākomanga. Ia wiki ka hoatu he kōrero hou ki a koutou katoa. Ko tāu mahi he whakarite i ngā kaupapa kōrero ka ahu mai i aua tuhinga mō taua wiki. 15% te wariu o ia whakahaere kaupapa kōrero me oti i a koe. Ko te aromatawai he titiro:

- pēhea tō āta tātari i ngā kōrero a te kaituhi?
- he aha ngā tino kaupapa kai roto i aua tuhinga?
- he aha ngā kupu tawhito, ngā kupu whakaniko, ngā āhuatanga reo e whakaatu ai i te tohungatanga o te tuhinga?
- he aha ētahi atu kōrero e ōrite ana ki taua tuhinga, pēnā he whakapapa anō tō taua tuhinga ki ētahi atu tuhinga o tōna rite?
- pēhea tō mahi whakahaere kaupapa kōrero/wānanga?

Ka whakahaere ēnei taumahi i te haora tuarua o te karaehe, nō reira ko tāu he whakarite, he whakahaere kōrero, ā, māu ū hoa e whakakōrero hoki.

8.1.2 Taumahi Tuarua

Whiwhinga 20%

Tuhia, titoa he waiata, haka, ngeri, mōteatea, rānei ko tōna taumata kia eke ki te taumata o ngā tohunga. Ko te tauira hei whāinga kia ōrite ki *Ngā Mōteatea*, ka mutu me whakapākehā hoki ki taua taumata. Ko te mea nui kia mau te wairua Māori, i takea mai i ngā pūmanawa o te ao Māori, kīhai i te ao Pākehā. Me whai i tā Te Kawa a Māui tikanga tuhi i ēnei kōrero, ā, kia kaua e neke atu i te 2000 ngā kupu.

8.1.3 Taumahi Tuatoru

Whiwhinga 25%

He mea pōhiri koe ki te tuku kauhau ki tētahi hui nui o te ao nā te mea ko koe te tohunga mō taua kaupapa, kāre i tua atu i a koe. Ko koe te tino mātanga o te whakanikoneko reo Māori, he pēhea tā te Māori whakamahi i tēnei tūāhua whakatakoto kōrero. He aha te/ngā hua o te whakaniko kōrero? Whakaritea he kaupapa e whakaatu ana i tō tohungatanga ki ngā āhua katoa o te whakaniko i te reo Māori. Me whai i tā Te Kawa a Māui tikanga tuhi i ēnei kōrero, ā, kia kaua e neke atu i te 2500 ngā kupu, kaua hoki e iti iho i te 2200 ngā kupu.

8.1.4 Tuari Kaupapa

Whiwhinga 25%

Tohua mai tētahi o ngā kaupapa mō ngā taumahi kua whakaritea e koe ka tuari ki te wānanga. Me kapi katoa i a koe ngā āhuatanga matua o tō kaupapa. Kaua e wareware he whakarāpopototanga noa tēnei o tō kaupapa. Haere ki te matū o ngā kōrero kia rangona tō tohungatanga ki tō kaupapa. He rua tekau meneti te roa, ka whai atu ngā uiuinga a te minenga whakarongo, he 5 meneti te roa.
