For the MTESOL, you'll do seven required (core) courses (three from Strand 1 and two each from Strands 2 and 3) and five extra (elective) courses that you can choose from any of the strands. For the PGDipTESOL you'll do six core courses (three from Strand 1, two from Strands 2, and one from Strand 3) and two elective courses. For the PGCertTESOL you will do four core courses (two from Strand 1 and one each from Strands 2 and 3).

For the **MAppLing**, you'll complete LALS 540 and LALS 541, and 150 further points from the table above. For the **PGDipAppLing**, you'll complete LALS 540 and LALS 541 and 90 further points from the table. For the **PGCertAppLing**, you'll complete LALS 540 and/or LALS 541 and further courses from the table to make up 60 points.
