Celebrating 20 years of the Bill of Rights: **Two Perspectives**

The 20th anniversary of the passing of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 is being celebrated by the New Zealand Centre for Public Law, with a seminar introducing two different perspectives on the Bill of Rights Act.

Sir Kenneth Keith, former Supreme Court judge and currently judge at the International Court of Justice in The Hague, and Rayhan Langdana, a 17year-old college student, will discuss the Bill of Rights Act.
