



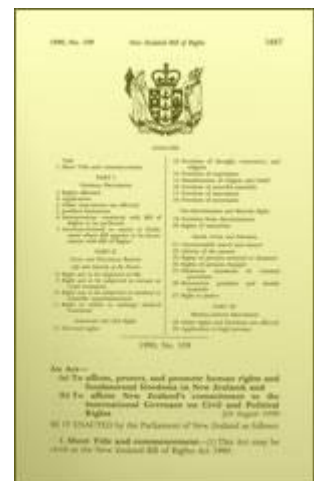
## SEMINAR

### Celebrating 20 years of the Bill of Rights: Two Perspectives

The 20th anniversary of the passing of the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 is being celebrated by the New Zealand Centre for Public Law, with a seminar introducing two different perspectives on the Bill of Rights Act.

**Sir Kenneth Keith**, former Supreme Court judge and currently judge at the International Court of Justice in The Hague, and **Rayhan Langdana**, a 17-year-old college student, will discuss the Bill of Rights Act. Sir Ken will speak about the aspirations for the legislation at its inception. Rayhan will address its meaning for a young person today.
